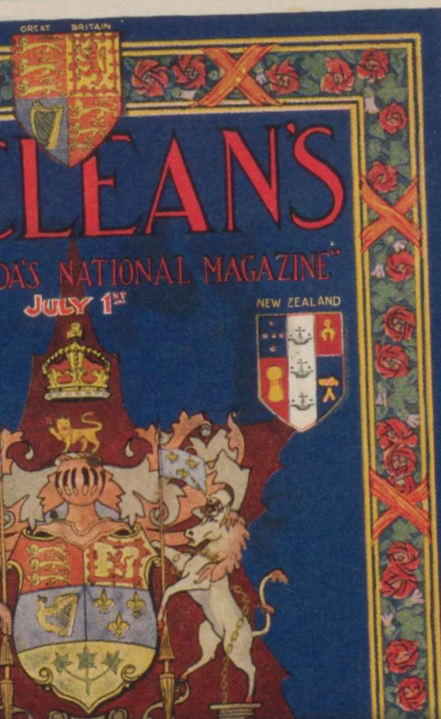

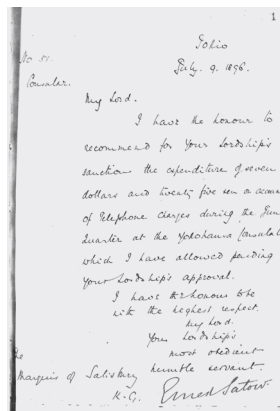

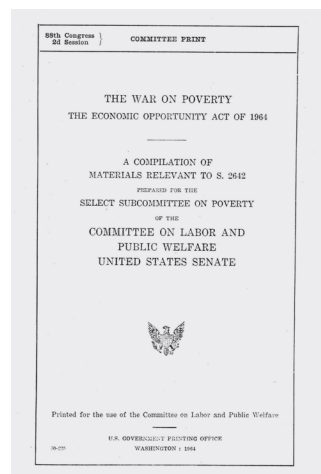

The Papers of Sir Ernest Mason Satow

Sir Ernest Mason Satow (1843–1929) was a legendary British diplomat, a key figure in East Asia and Anglo-Japanese and -Chinese relations, particularly in Bakumatsu (1853–1867) and Meiji Era (1868–1912) Japan, and in China after the Boxer Rebellion (1900–1906).

This collection, sourced from the UK National Archives, consists of Satow's private, diplomatic, and other correspondence; letter books; diaries; and papers. His diaries cover a period of over sixty-five years (1861 to 1926). Apart from a few drafts among those addressed to Lord Reay, the letters are all originals, which appear to have been returned to Sir Ernest Satow after the deaths of their recipients.



The War on Poverty and the Office of Economic Opportunity: Part 1: Records of the Office of Civil Rights, 1965-1968

This collection provides a window into the implementation of President Lyndon B. Johnson's civil rights program in the War on Poverty. The centerpiece of the War on Poverty was the Economic Opportunity Act of 1964, which created an Office of Economic Opportunity (OEO) to oversee a variety of community-based antipoverty programs. The collection contains correspondence, memoranda, reports, minutes of meetings, convention programs, and other records concerning the activities of Maurice Dawkins, Assistant Director for Civil Rights in the Office of Economic Opportunity. Many of the files contain information regarding civil rights leaders such as Martin Luther King, Jr; Roy Wilkins; Whitney Young; and Andrew Young.
